Footnotes

PHOTO SHOPPED broke alertly but was rated off the leaders from the outside, moved a bit closer into the second turn, circled rivals four wide to the stretch, rallied determinedly and was up late to win driving. DUKE OF DOOM was not asked for speed early, followed the winner into the stretch and finished steadily. DIXICO stalked the pace three wide from the outset, had his best bid inside the furlong pole but could not hold the top two. DEACON SPEAKIN' was void of any early speed, raced just off the rail while still trailing on the second turn, came to the extreme outside for the drive and closed fastest. CONTROL SEEKER broke to the outside at the start and took back to be three wide to the backstretch, came two wide on the second turn and finished willingly. MR. CANDY BAR settled early from off the rail, remained two wide on the second turn but lacked a closing response. DUNMORE EAST dueled from the rail for six furlongs, edged clear briefly nearing the furlong pole but had little left for the drive. ACAFFELLA was well position from the inside to the stretch but did not rally. CODY PEAK raced unhurried to the second turn, then saved ground but lacked a closing response. PIANA MAN dueled two wide for six furlongs and came up empty.
