DOWNTOWN C. T. tracked the leaders from the outset, had to wait for room behind those rivals much of the turn, got through once in the stretch, rallied quickly to gain command inside the furlong pole and edged clear driving. JACK'S GONE stalked the pace from the outset, rallied three wide to the lead in the upper stretch but could not match strides with the winner. FLY BLUE lagged early, raced two wide on the turn and offered a menacing rally to the furlong pole then lost his punch. SHRED THE SECRETS settled early, eased four wide for room on the turn but lacked the needed response. SPARKLE JOEL saved ground to no avail. UNDERTOW rushed up inside TWO PARTS in the opening quarter to gain command but gave way nearing the quarter pole. PROSPERO settled early, raced four wide on the turn and did not rally. TWO PARTS showed good early speed, prompted the pace to mid turn and gave out. HOLLYWOOD FREDIE had no speed.
