Footnotes

J. J. MAROUN dueled for the lead from the rail to the backstretch, edged clear to the second turn, responded and remained clear to the stretch then held under steady encouragement. EMPEROROFOTHERACES lagged to the second turn, advanced inside to the stretch then shifted off the rail and closed steadily to the line. NUMEROUS XS stalked the pace to the half, commenced a bid two wide on the second turn, briefly loomed a factor into the stretch but was outfinished to the line. MATT THE VET had no speed for a half while three wide, made a bid two wide into the second turn, angled out nearing the quarter pole then came up empty in the drive. BUFFER ZONE was fanned four wide to the backstretch, settled behind horses to the second turn, got pushed five wide by COUNT ANOMAR into the stretch and lacked a late response. SWISS EXCHANGE dueled from between horses early, chased the winner to the second turn, was tiring then had to steady off of MATT THE VET'S heels and gave out. COUNT ANOMAR dueled three wide early, stalked to the second turn then drifted out while tiring and stopped in the drive.
