CALLDEROLL broke alertly but was permitted to slip back just off the leaders, moved up three wide on the turn, continued to respond in the drive and got up in the final stride. SRIRACHA raced up inside after the start to duel early, edged clear on the turn and upper stretch then just failed to last. GIFTED STUDENT stalked the pace from the inside but lacked the needed response. TWIST MY KAZOO slipped back after the start, saved ground on the turn but did not rally. BROWN SALT lagged early, raced two wide on the turn and was never a factor. HIGH ON THE DERBY dueled outside early, stopped on the turn and was eased in the stretch but walked off. NASSAU GOLD raced within striking distance to the turn then began to bear out and fell past the three eighths pole.
