EVENING ISLAND was permitted to settle early, began to advance into the turn, came three wide to the stretch to gain command once straightened for the drive and drew clear driving. DR. PROCTER raced unhurried early, circled four wide on the turn to loom a factor once in the stretch but proved no match for the winner. COMIC BABY settled early within striking distance, raced just off the rail on the turn but failed to rally. LORD TORRENT broke through the gate prior to the start then lacked early speed, came advanced three wide to the stretch but failed to sustain his bid. SUMMER AT THE LAKE prompted the pace two wide, led briefly in the upper stretch and gave out. STEPPINGINTHELIGHT emerged from between horses after the break to set the pace without need of urging, led to the head of the lane and stopped suddenly. MUSIC APPEAL stalked the pace from the rail to mid turn and stopped.
