JUST AFTER SUNSET was outsprinted to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch, rallied then had to angle out for room in mid stretch, continued to respond and was up in time. MADI TWO SHOES stalked the pace to the turn, moved up to duel four wide to the stretch, was outkicked to mid stretch but kept on late, had a short lead in the very late stages but was nailed by the winner on the line. HARD HEARTED LADY tracked the leaders to the turn, bid three wide to the stretch then responded to pressure through a long drive but was outfinished in the late going. OLD WAY chased the pace to the turn, saved ground and advanced into the stretch, loomed a threat to mid stretch then stayed on late but was also outfinished. KISSES FOR KATE set a pressured pace from the rail to the stretch, inched away to mid stretch, stayed on to inside the sixteenth marker then was outkicked by rivals in the final yards. LIL RED JET got outsprinted to the turn, was four wide to the stretch but came up empty in the drive. A LITTLE POLISH had no speed and was not a factor. COUNTRY GOLD flashed speed to mid turn then tired and stopped in the stretch.
