SUMMER HIT established command early and rated nicely while not being challenged from the inside, responded once in the stretch and held gamely. HUDSON LANDING was well positioned early two wide, swung three wide on the second turn and closed steadily. ADMINISTER lagged early from off the rail, circled rivals four wide on the second turn and finished well while not bothering the top two. SIBERIAN LAUGHTER was permitted to settle early from the rail, commenced his rally two wide on the second turn, split foes in the stretch and finished willingly. CONTROL SEEKER stalked the winner two wide to the stretch and gave way. POSITIVE RESPONSE race unhurried early from the outside, remained out on the second turn but had no response. ASHTAR (CHI) lagged early from the rail, came two wide on the second turn but failed to mount a rally. TRES BORRACHOS stalked from the rail to the second turn and came up empty.
