HEXBREAKER broke cleanly and took a good striking position just off the dueling leaders, rallied three wide into the stretch to take command, edged clear then held off REAGAN REPUBLICAN late. REAGAN REPUBLICAN was permitted to settle early, raced up behind the leaders on the turn to be boxed into the stretch, eased out once in the lane and finished willingly. ROSEMOUNT LAD was not asked for speed early, saved ground into the stretch and finished willingly. EXCESSIVE WAGER broke alertly then fell back at the start, came three wide on the turn and closed a gap late. MCMURTRY rushed up from the rail to duel to the turn, edged a bid clear to the head of the lane then had little left. STREET CAR dueled two wide from the outset, led briefly in the upper stretch but slackened in the final furlong. FIRSTCLASSTRAVELER raced unhurried early, was fanned four wide on the turn and failed to rally. SALTY LE MOUSEE showed little. FIREFLY BAY was well placed to the turn and stopped.
