FARMER GILES (IRE) broke alertly and took a favorable striking position from the inside then raced unhurried, remained inside entering the stretch, responded to rally to the lead leaving the furlong pole and won driving. RED COATS R COMIN took command into the first turn and crossed to the rail, set all of the pace unpressured but could not hold the winner in the final furlong. SANDOR (GB) raced in check behind horses into the first turn then settled, saved ground on the second turn and came on for the show. RENZO SEAN chased the pace from the outset then went evenly through the lane but pulled up lame and was vanned off. THE TOUR DIRECTOR trailed to the second turn, came three wide to the stretch but lacked the needed response. STORMY SURGE settled early three wide, raced between horses on the second turn then failed to respond in the lane. MOSCATO was unhurried early while four wide to the backstretch, offered a brief rally three wide on the second turn but came up empty in the lane.
