**Footnotes**

MISTER STANKY settled mid pack to the half, was roused into the second turn, rallied four wide to the stretch, dueled to deep stretch then inched away under strong urging. HURRICANE DEPUTY walked out of the gate then bobbled briefly, trailed to the half, began to rally into the second turn but was forced to circle five wide into the stretch then finished steadily to the line. TAHOE BLUES was three wide early then eased to the rail on the backstretch, saved ground and advanced on the second turn, loomed boldly to deep stretch but was outfinished late. CARSON'S MELODY chased the pace to the second turn, rallied two wide to the stretch then finished willingly late. ROMAN ACCOUNT pressed the pace to the second turn, moved up to duel two wide to the stretch, battled to mid stretch but weakened in the final sixteenth. TAKIN A BREAK also chased to the half, came two wide to the stretch but failed to mount a serious response. LIFT MY EYES set the pace to the second turn, responded to pressure to mid stretch but weakened in the final eighth mile. A NEW LEVEL settled early then saved ground, closed well to reach contention to mid stretch but lost his punch in the final furlong. KING'S QUEST was not a factor.
