Footnotes

CROXIE took back early and raced unhurried to the second turn, rallied quickly from off the rail to get up behind the leaders while boxed, waited until once in the lane, shifted outside DEXTERA then ran down that rival past mid stretch and won going away driving. DEXTERA (GER) was under a snug hold early from off the rail, moved up without need of urging on the second turn to circle the leaders four wide into the lane, took command near the furlong pole but could not stall the winner. MEAN JOLEENE was permitted to settle early from the rail, advanced two wide on the second turn, rallied to mid stretch, was forced to alter course outside CEE THE LADY then dug in and finished steadily. MYSTERIOUS MARISSA lagged early from the inside, offered a menacing bid five wide on the second turn but flattened out in the stretch. CEE THE LADY was a bit wide forcing the pace into the first turn, took command once on the backstretch and set the pace from off the rail to the upper stretch and slackened. CHARS PROBLEM stalked the pace four and three wide for six furlongs and gave out. LOW EXPECTATIONS set the early pace from the inside but was through after five furlongs. DIXIE LUCKY tracked the pace three wide early, dropped inside into the second turn and gave out.
