RED SHARP HUMOR was never too far back while racing off the rail, came just outside DUKE OF DOOM to be two wide into the stretch, raced up behind the leaders at the furlong pole, switched outside then offered a quick late bid and was up in the final stride. NORTHERN CAUSEWAY set all of the pace from just off the rail, maintained a slim advantage in the stretch and was tagged in only the final step. MR. CANDY BAR pressed the pace three wide early, was two wide into the stretch and raced gamely between horses. DUKE OF DOOM settled early from the rail, rallied just inside the winner into the stretch, lacked room briefly at the furlong pole, switched inside and came on willingly. MACHO DORADO stalked the pace from the inside to the second turn, angled three wide on the second turn to rally into the stretch, loomed a bold factor past the furlong pole but slackened slightly between horses and clipped the heels of the winner past the finish line. OVER THE BUDGET race unhurried early from off the rail, saved ground on the second turn but lacked the needed response. MENTIDOSO lagged early and failed to reach contention. CHIN'N TONIC (IRE) was permitted to settle early, raced three wide throughout but failed to rally. FORMULA GOLD was never a factor, the stewards posted the inquiry and reviewed the finish but ruled that MACHO DORADO clipped heels after the finish and allowed the original finish to stand.
