Footnotes

STAR OF MADRAAR broke alertly and took a favorable striking position into the first turn while crossing to the rail, raced under patient handling to the second turn, eased outside BONFIRE BURT into the stretch to gain command, edged clear then had enough left to hold SAN FRAN late. SANFRAN raced unhurried from off the rail to the second turn, came through inside horses to the stretch to reach serious contention and close4d steadily outside the winner. TRATO was permitted to settle early from the rail but was always within striking distance, advanced in front of SAN FRAN on the second turn, could not

quite rally with that rival in the lane but finished steadily. RUSH COUNTRY stalked the pace from the rail to the second turn, moved up three wide to the head of the lane then flattened out. PLENTY OF HEAT lagged early, came through inside on the second turn to improve his placing to the stretch then hung. SMILING KING lagged to the second turn, circled four wide to the stretch but failed to offer a serious bid. BONFIRE BURT set the pace from the inside to the stretch and gave out. QUINQUIN THE KING (FR) settled early while three wide to the backstretch, was two wide and between horses on the second turn but did not muster a closing response. PRINCETON (IRE) pressed the pace two wide for six furlongs and gave out. RUN TO THE BORDER was well placed early, raced three wide throughout but had nothing left once on the second turn. DEVIL CIELO settled early while four wide to the backstretch then fell back steadily. GET OFF THE SUGAR could not keep up and was eased in the stretch but walked off.
