Footnotes

PHANTOM ALI broke cleanly and took a favorable striking position in the opening quarter from the three path, remained three wide into the lane, responded past the furlong pole to gain command late and won going away driving. LOOK TO THE SKY raced unhurried early from the three path, angled outside PHANTOM ALI into the stretch, loomed a bold factor at the furlong pole but could not match strides with that rival late. SIX CENTS OF HUMOR tracked the pace of THAINTY from the outside, moved up outside that rival on the second turn to gain command, drifted out a bit into the lane to lose the lead but finished gamely. THAINTY took a clear early lead into the first turn from the rail, gave up the advantage on the second turn but kept to her task to regain the lead a furlong out then faltered late. WHIMS AND FANCIES settled early from the rail just inside the winner, advanced from off the rail on the second turn but lacked the needed response late. HEART'S MUSIC trailed through but was finishing well from the inside.
