FOUR TO SCORE was a pace factor outside the runnerup to the turn, inched away from that one to the stretch then responded in the drive and was clear driving. FREE RETURN was pushed along early, dueled from the rail to the turn, was outkicked to mid stretch then was outfinished by the winner but saved second. I'LL RUN THE SHOW stalked the leaders from the rail to mid turn, swung out three wide nearing the quarter pole, tried to respond to urging but went evenly late. FAR OUT chased the pace three wide to the stretch but lacked a closing response. WINE AND SONG was outsprinted, also was chasing to the turn then saved ground to the stretch but weakened in mid stretch. UNMARKED BILLS had no speed and was not a threat.
