HUNTSVILLE was permitted to settle to the second turn, had to circle rivals four wide while rallying to the stretch, was up to duel TWO BUCKS TO WIN in mid stretch then dug in determinedly to edge clear late. POCKET PRINCE had no speed and trailed to the second turn, closed the gap while saving ground to the stretch then finished willingly late to grab the place. TWO BUCKS TO WIN chased the pace to the half, bid two then three wide to the stretch, dueled with the winner past mid stretch, stayed on to deep stretch but tired in the late stages. EVER ALERT was hustled to the front, set all the pace for five furlongs, was collared leaving the quarter pole and weakened in the drive. BLUES BLASTER had no speed, raced two wide on the second turn but failed to rally. A. P. CORSAIR prompted the pace for five furlongs, made a run two wide on the second turn to be among the leaders into the stretch but had nothing left for the drive.
