Footnotes

DANZ WITH K J was hustled but lacked any early speed, chased to the turn, advanced inside to the stretch, got through along the rail inside of FLASHY PLAYER then responded to steady urging, battled AMERICAN ARISTOCRAT through the final sixteenth and earned a hard-fought nod. AMERICAN ARISTOCRAT was also used in the early stages but was outsprinted, came two wide to the stretch then rallied determinedly through the final furlong and just missed. REBEL MY MAN chased the leader to the turn, bid three wide to the stretch, was a factor to mid stretch then lost his punch but nabbed MIDWAY SURF for the show. MIDWAY SURF also was chasing the clear leader to the turn, rallied three wide and pushed to the front in mid stretch but weakened in the final sixteenth. MR. SANS SOUCI was a step slow at the beginning and trailed, came two wide to the stretch then failed to mount a serious threat. CARDIO ROYALE had no speed and was outrun. FLASHY PLAYER scooted clear in the opening furlong, led to the quarter pole but tired badly in the stretch, was eased but walked off.
