SPRING BLOOM took a favorable striking position early and raced unhurried to the second turn, rallied three wide into the stretch, gained command past the furlong pole and won driving. HARBOR SONG set all of the pace from off the rail, maintained an advantage to mid stretch then could not stall the winner. LADY'S PLAN tracked the pace from the rail, eased three wide on the second turn and finished in a mild rally. COOKIELAMOUR tracked inside rivals to the stretch and lacked a closing response. LOVE TALE (GB) lagged early, saved ground on the second turn, rallied toe the furlong pole and flattened out. BROADMOOR DE LIGHT was never a factor. STORMY RANDIE settled early, raced four wide on the second turn and came up empty. SKINNY GENES was always outrun.
