Footnotes

GLOBAL GLOW never far back to the half, circled rivals while rallying four wide to the stretch, dueled to mid stretch, took a short lead in deep stretch then held off BIG COZZ late. BIG COZZ tracked the leaders in the compact field to the second turn, raced two then three wide to the stretch, rallied in the final furlong then surged late but missed. EDDINGTONFORGIANNA stalked the pace to the half, bid three wide and was up to dispute the lead on the second turn, remained a threat to mid stretch but lost his punch in the late going. FREE BEER was a pace factor while two wide for six furlongs but lacked a late response in the final furlong. VULCAN dueled from the rail to the second turn, gave way to the stretch then stopped in the stretch, was eased but walked off.
