**Footnotes**

MAJESTIC AMERICAN prompted the pace to the backstretch, saved ground on the second turn, responded inside through the drive and drove clear. VELIKAYA set the pace while off the rail to the second turn, responded to mid stretch then could not stall the winner while best of the rest. AWESOME JARED was four wide to the backstretch, tracked the pace to the second turn, was fanned out four wide to the stretch then could not make an impact late. SMOKIN DIXI tracked the pace to the second turn, also was fanned four wide to the stretch but came up empty in the drive. RED RIVER KING saved ground throughout but failed to rally when asked in the drive. WALKER RD. had no speed, was two wide on the second turn but also lacked a closing response. SURFER DAVE stalked the pace for a half mile, offered a bid three wide on the second turn to briefly loom a threat but gave out through the stretch.
