Footnotes

PORTFOLIO was unhurried for a half mile, rallied two wide on the second turn, pushed past the runnerup in upper stretch then held on doggedly to the line. TIZ O' GOLD was four wide to the backstretch, settled to the second turn, bid three wide and dueled to the stretch, was outkicked by the winner to mid stretch but dug in late to save second. NIP OF GOLD had no speed, settled for a half mile, bid three wide on the second turn then could not sustain the needed late response. COZZENA ANGELINA trailed to the second turn, came three wide to the stretch but lacked a closing response. GREELEY'S AGENDA chased the leader early then was outrun by that one on the backstretch, raced off the rail to the stretch but was giving ground in the final furlong. WICKED TRIP was hustled to the front while four wide into the first turn, eased down to the two path and kicked away on the backstretch but began to tired after five eighths and gave out in the stretch. KEE NOODLE tracked the pace three wide while a factor for three eighths, was outrun by rivals to the second turn then also gave out.
