Footnotes

MELODY MAKIN tracked the dueling leaders early from just off the rail, set out after PAPIKA RED on the second turn, gained command in the upper stretch, edged clear then just did have enough to hold. CATSALOT was not asked for speed early while saving ground to the backstretch, eased outside into the second turn, raced in the four path to the stretch and closed steadily. PAPIKA RED set the early pace outside FLIRT WITH JUSTICE, dropped to the inside once clear on that rival on the backstretch, maintained an advantage to the head of the lane then gradually weakened. FLIRT WITH JUSTICE dueled early from the rail, did not go with PAPIKA RED once on the backstretch but remained a factor from the inside to the head of the lane and weakened. SECRET LIMIT settled early while three wide to the backstretch, dropped inside into the stretch but lacked a closing response. DA HEAT was permitted to settle early then failed to rally while three wide on the second turn. FLYINTHEPOLARROUTE stalked the pace from off the rail for six furlongs and came up empty. HI FLYIN STORM was never a factor.
