LUCKY BET drifted out six wide while pushing clear into the backstretch, set the pace to the stretch, responded to strong urging and held determinedly. WALKER RD. had early speed then dropped back on the backstretch, was crowded by KEYNIENTOS and shuffled back into the second turn, shifted out for room in upper stretch then found room between rivals, dug in gamely and surged in the final yards. ALABAMA BOY was four wide early, settled to the second turn, raced three wide to the stretch then finished steadily but could not get there. KEYNIENTOS was also four wide early, chased the pace to the second turn, rallied inside to loom a factor into the stretch but went evenly in the late stages. THE MAJOR settled mid pack to the half, offered his best rally outside the winner on the second turn, stayed on to deep stretch but weakened in the late stages.
