FU PEG HE RAT was unhurried to the half, rallied two wide on the second turn, swung out for room into the stretch, got clear in upper stretch and closed resolutely through the final furlong to be along in time. LAMM saved ground while tracking the leaders to the half, raced three wide and rallied to the stretch, pushed to the front a furlong out then could not stall the winner while second best. NINER GENIUS tracked the pace to the second turn, got fanned four wide to the stretch, loomed to mid stretch but was outkicked by the top two through the final furlong. LANG FIELD alternated on the lead for six furlongs, was two wide to the stretch but weakened through the drive. GLOBAL HEAT stalked the leaders to the second turn, offered a bid three wide to the stretch but lost his punch. CAHILL COUNTRY vied for the lead to the second turn, was inside to the stretch then also tired through the drive. NORTHERN J C stumbled at the start, was never a factor then was eased when hopelessly beaten but walked off.
