RAISE THE HEAT was never too far back while racing off the rail, eased out on the second turn to circle the leaders four wide into the lane, gained command in mid stretch and pulled clear driving. RED WAGON was well placed three wide from the early stages, moved up on the second turn to take command in the upper stretch but could not stall the winner. SKY WOLF set all of the pace from the inside to the upper stretch and slackened. MARBURY raced unhurried while dropping to the rail on the first turn, raced just off the rail on the second turn, eased out once in the stretch and finished steadily. SANFRAN lagged well back to the second turn, came four wide to the stretch and finished willingly. SPUNKY HARRY raced close up from the rail to the stretch then came up empty. SPEED ROUSER raced well back to the second turn, saved ground into the lane but lacked the needed response. CRAVENS was void of early speed and failed to rally. DRIVEN BY EXCESS pressed the pace two wide to the second turn, stopped then pulled up lame and was vanned off. STRANGE BREW stalked the pace between horses, weakened on the second turn then steadied sharply off the heels of MARBURY nearing the furlong pole then was not persevered with to the line.
