DEVIL'S ISSUE stalked the winner from the rail throughout but could make no impact. UNCOMMON SENSE raced unhurried early, was just off the rail on the turn and finished willingly. AT LAST A WILDCAT was well placed early three wide but lacked the needed response. KID ATLANTIC stalked the pace from the outside, had his best bid from the three path on the turn but weakened in the lane. MY MANS NO LADY prompted the winner from the three path to the turn and faded steadily.
