PHEISTY KID was sent for speed, dueled inside the runnerup to the stretch, dug in gamely in deep stretch and inched away late. LOOP CURRENT EDDIE was on the pace from the outset, dueled two wide to the stretch, responded determinedly to deep stretch then was outkicked in the late stages. ROCKIN DENILE got outsprinted to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch and closed the gap steadily in the final furlong. FOOGARD chased the top two two wide to the stretch then could not muster the needed late response. TRIBAL AGAIN had no speed, raced outside a rival to the stretch and was gaining ground belatedly. DEMON DANCER also had no speed, came two wide to the stretch and closed the gap to the line. MONDAI MONDAI chased the leaders three wide to the stretch but came up empty in the drive. GENEROUS GEORGE saved ground to no avail. THREE STRIKE RULE showed little.
