MABADI broke alertly then took back off LOGAN AVENUE LINDA and stalked in hand from the rail to the second turn, moved up inside that rival nearing the quarter pole to take command, responded to the whip leaving the furlong pole then drew clear during her best without further need of coaxing. VEYANA (FR) lagged three wide early, then dropped to the rail once in the stretch the first time, remained inside on the final turn to rally into the stretch but lacked the needed response. CHRISTMAS STOCKING stalked the pace three wide from the outset, challenged for command at the quarter pole but could not sustain her bid. TAHTHEEB (IRE) raced unhurried to the second turn, came three wide to the stretch but failed to rally. LOGAN AVENUE LINDA set all of the pace from off the rail to the quarter pole then gave way between horses. AWESOME BEGINNING was always outrun.
