Footnotes

BEEZAROO took back at the start and crossed to the rail and raced unhurried, commenced her bid two wide on the second turn, shifted to the extreme outside once in the stretch, offered a quick, bold rally to take command past mid stretch and drew clear driving. HILL OF TARA set all of the pace from off the rail, took her longest lead at the furlong pole but could not hold the winner. JESI'S MAKIN MAGIC tracked the pace from the inside throughout but could only go evenly in the drive. MISS LAKE was well placed early from the rail, rallied three wide into the stretch to loom a factor but hung in the final furlong. DOLORIS raced unhurried early, was two wide on both turns the lacked the needed rally. MY SISTER SANDY was well positioned three wide early, tried to rally four wide on the second turn but came up empty. ITSPHUN settled early from off the rail, saved ground on the second turn but did not respond. A TONY FOR AMBE was never a factor.
