Footnotes

BETRAYER stalked GRETI from the outset under a snug hold, advanced to that rival from the outside entering the stretch, responded once called upon and drew clear to win driving. WATCHMAN'S COVE (NZ) settled inside early, commenced her bid three wide on the second turn, loomed a bold factor in the upper stretch and lost her punch. R SEATTLE SUZIE raced unhurried to the second turn, advanced four wide to the stretch and flattened out. GRETI, off a step slow, was quickly in front to set all of the pace to the stretch and slackened from the inside. DESERT DRY SACK lacked early speed or a closing response in a dull try. PENNYWELL (GB), well positioned from the outside to the second turn, offered a brief bid three wide but could not sustain her speed. NAUGHTY PATTI settled inside, broke stride briefly nearing the half mile pole and fell back steadily in the final quarter.
