KOFINHO was outrun to the turn, advanced two wide to the stretch then shifted out, responded to urging and wore down both HARRY THE BOOK and SUNDAY SEEKER to win going away. HARRY THE BOOK contested the pace outside of SUNDAY SEEKER, responded to pressure to deep stretch then could not stall the winner but saved the place late. SUNDAY SEEKER vied for the lead from the rail to the stretch, responded to deep stretch then was outfinished by the winner and lost the nod for second. FORTY CTS stalked the leaders to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch but failed to mount a late response. ROCKAWAY MOON was very green in the early stages, fell far behind, began to respond mid way on the turn and was gaining ground through the drive. LORD TORRENT tracked the leaders to the turn then was fanned four wide to the stretch and gave way. STATELY TOM also tracked the pace outside of LORD TORRENT, was five wide to the stretch then gave out in the final furlong, pulled up lame before the clubhouse turn and was vanned off.
