### Footnotes

MERRY MARINO was well placed outside rivals and three wide to the second turn, rallied three wide to the stretch then dug in determinedly through the final furlong to wear down FLYING HOME late. FLYING HOME The latter pressed the pace for five furlongs, rallied two wide on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch then resisted the winner to deep stretch before giving way late. BLIND OPTIMISM set a pressured pace to the second turn, was engaged by the runnerup, briefly stayed on to the stretch then came up empty in the drive. CRAZY TRICIA never far away for five furlongs, raced two wide to the stretch but could not muster the needed response. KATIEINTHEFASTLANE close up while chasing the pace to the second turn from the rail, lacked a responded in the stretch. ANGEL'S LAW went wrong in the opening furlong, was pulled up and vanned off.
