Footnotes

DESERT BOOM was coaxed to an early advantage without being rushed and set all of the pace under fine rating, drew clear on the second turn, took his longest lead at the furlong pole then held driving. EASY MILLION was permitted to lag to the second turn, commenced his bid at the three eighths pole, got through inside then shifted outside YOUNGOTTAWANNA at the quarter pole, moved nearest the winner nearing the furlong pole then closed steadily but could make no impact. YOUNGOTTAWANNA prompted the winner two wide to the second turn then gradually weakened. SMOOCHER was permitted to settle early while three wide to the backstretch, tried to rally four wide on the second turn but lacked the needed response. MAMBO TRAIN raced unhurried to the second turn then passed only tiring horses. SKIPASLEW stalked the pace from the rail to the second turn, angled three wide nearing the stretch but came up empty. BEST MINISTER was forwardly placed from off the rail to the second turn and stopped suddenly.
