**Footnotes**

KATIEINTHEFASTLANE was rated mid pack to the half, rallied three wide on the second turn, responded when set down for the drive and gradually wore down RIVER SLANEY late. The latter was hustled to the first turn then drifted out four wide, straightened and prompted the pace to the half, bid outside of ELEGANT LOOQ and took over on the second turn, responded to deep stretch then gave way grudgingly. SUETOSUETOSUE broke alertly then was outsprinted to the first turn, stalked the pace to the half, bid two wide into the second turn then was boxed in behind RIVER SLANEY and had to wait for room to develop, was roused again when clear in upper stretch but was outfinished. P TOWN TOPPER had no speed, raced two wide into the second turn, eased three wide into the stretch then finished evenly in the final furlong. JUMPIN JANET was allowed to settle for a half, came two wide on the second turn but also went evenly through the drive. TOO HOT TO TOUCH had no speed, tried to rally three deep on the second turn but came up empty in the lane. AUNT BESSIE tracked the pace for a half mile, was forced four wide to the stretch then gave way. ELEGANT LOOQ drifted out while showing speed to the first turn and was five wide, eased back to the three path to the backstretch, set a pressured pace to the second turn then was collared and tired in the stretch. REAL AWSOME JET was four wide on the first turn then was not a factor.
