CITY ROUTE broke alertly and went right to the front, set the pace to the stretch then dug in resolutely through the final furlong to prevail. SOLD SHORT prompted the winner to the turn, was asked for more two wide nearing the quarter pole, could not make an impact late but gamely saved second. MIGHTY MONSOON chased the pace to the turn, made a bid three wide to the stretch but lost his punch in the late stages. ROLL YOUR EYES also chased the leader early, was two wide to mid turn, got pushed out three wide into the stretch then lacked a closing response. BABY BLAKE stalked the pace early, saved ground to the stretch but weakened in the drive. COMPASS ROCK was close up in the early stages then was crowded inside, sucked back to last and never threatened.
