Footnotes

AMBERMOSC was a pace factor from the outset, bid two wide to the stretch then dug in willingly through a long drive and got the nod on the line. PIMIENTO NEGRO showed good speed, dueled to the turn, inched away to the stretch, responded when hooked by the winner a furlong out, battled gamely to the line and just missed. TSHULTRIM had no speed, came two wide to the stretch then finished in a rally along the rail. INTENTIONAL SAINT chased the leaders to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch but lacked a closing response. SHILOH'S PAC BOOM also chased the pace to the turn, was outside of INTENTIONAL SAINT and four wide to the stretch then came up empty. BOY BLUE CORN stalked the pace to the turn, was caught out four wide to the stretch and tired. TWAIN'S PRESSION had no speed and was outrun. JUDICIAL MATTER tracked the pace early, saved ground on the turn, steadied to avoid heels mid turn and tired through the stretch. UNTOUCHABLE TODD saved ground to no avail.
