Footnotes

HOT CHACO took back after the start and raced unhurried while three wide to the backstretch, commenced his rally once on the second turn, split foes two wide into the lane, shifted out near the furlong pole and rallied steadily to gain command late and won going away driving. SEE ZO GO took command in the early stages to set all of the pace from the inside under pressure, responded gamely in the lane but could not quite stall the winner. SR AUSTIN pressed the pace two wide throughout and finished steadily. CEE'S CLOSING TIME was permitted to settle early, saved ground throughout but lacked the needed response. BALLESTERO stalked the pace three wide throughout but slackened in the final quarter. THE TOUR DIRECTOR lagged early from off the rail, saved ground on the second turn and came on late without being a serious factor. CLASSICAL BARTOK raced unhurried early from the rail, was in the two path on the second turn but did not respond. PARKBENCH was not asked for speed early while crossing to the rail, came two wide on the second turn but failed to reach contention. SUMMER SUNSHINE was well placed early two wide but gave way four wide on the second turn.
