Footnotes

PRIMARY NOTICE drifted inward shortly after the start while still in the chute, flashed good speed, dueled from the rail to the stretch, responded to edge clear to mid stretch then was all out to hold on. PUNCH UP was crowded by the winner and checked in the chute, dropped back and was outrun two wide to the stretch then eased out in upper stretch and closed with a rush but was too late. BRUNO'S WAGER chased the pace to the turn, saved ground to the stretch then also responded in the final furlong but was outfinished. SHEEKEY (IRE) was allowed to settle early, was caught out four wide to the stretch then lacked the needed late response. SALTY SID stalked the leaders to the turn, bid three wide to be a factor into the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. SO BEHOLD was quickly in stride and dueled from between rivals to the stretch but tired after five furlongs. CYPRESS SAM had no speed and was not a threat. An objection was lodged by the rider on PUNCH UP against PRIMARY NOTICE for alleged interference shortly after the start but although the stewards acknowledged some crowding, they did not believe it cost PUNCH UP a placing so no change in the order was warranted.
