APRIL was unhurried for a half mile, bid two wide on the second turn, shifted out for room in upper stretch then rallied once clear and was along in time. BOOT N IT tracked the pace to the half, rallied three wide on the second turn, responded in the stretch, was outfinished by the winner but got the nod for second. GHOST SHADOW was allowed to settle for a half mile, circled rivals four wide to the stretch then also finished steadily but was outrun late. COMMENDABLE QUEEN prompted the pace to the second turn, rallied three wide and took over into the stretch, inched away to mid stretch but was tiring late. FANCEY ENDEVOR steadied off heels nearing the three quarter pole, settled to the second turn, was inside rivals to the stretch then had to steady again when crowded by TRIBAL LORE at the three sixteenths but was gaining again once clear. JESSABOOM had no speed, raced two wide throughout and was not a threat. FLYING WITH SULLY saved ground to no avail. TRIBAL LORE set the pace in hand to the second turn then stopped.
