Footnotes

CAPT. SPARROW took back at the start and raced unhurried to the second turn, eased out at the three eighths pole and was fanned four wide into the stretch, rallied steadily to gain command, ducked out nearing the wire and just held. IDLE CHATTER lagged from off the rail to the second turn, advanced two wide to the stretch behind a wall of horses, came to the outside and rallied steadily. PRIVATE ASSETS broke slow and settled early, advanced inside steadily into the lane, was blocked in the upper stretch, eased out searching for a path in the lane, rallied strongly inside IDLE CHATTER late but was forced to steady sharply off CAPT. SPARROW in the final strides. FUNNY PAPERS settled early from the rail, eased two wide on the second turn, rallied to mid stretch and lost some of his punch. FIGHTING CITY HALL pressed the pace two wide from the outset, took command in the upper stretch but slackened late. SEVENGOLDNMISSILES was void of early speed, raced two wide to the stretch, came to the outside for the drive and finished willingly. CASE STUDY set all of the pace from the inside to the stretch and weakened. R FAT MAN tracked the leaders from the rail into the stretch then faded. SUFFOLK PUNCH was well placed three wide for six furlongs and came up empty. Following an objection from the rider aboard PRIVATE ASSETS, CAPT SPARROW was disqualified for interference nearing the finish and was placed third.
