Footnotes

JUMANAH broke cleanly but was not asked for speed in the early stages, set out after the leaders from just off the rail on the turn, rallied to the lead at the furlong pole and edged clear driving. FOR SURE FOR SURE raced unhurried early, saved ground to the stretch, offered her bid nearing the furlong pole but flattened out late. CAN'T TOPPER stalked the pace from the outset, was three wide on the turn and went evenly through the drive. CAROLINE ELENA dueled from off the rail and weakened. BAD GIRL BAD GIRL broke with the leaders but was shuffled back between horses leaving the half mile pole, dropped inside to remain a factor to the head of the lane and faded. DIANA'S AVENUE was forward placed early, raced four wide on the turn but did not rally. PERFECT CURLS broke slow then rushed to the lead from the inside, bore out to the six path on the turn and gave way. MAVICSA settled early, raced off the rail on the turn and had no response.
