AWESOME SILVER broke alertly then was permitted to slip back, advanced steadily four wide to the stretch, continued his rally in the lane and was up late. HOPE 'N PRAY raced unhurried early from the inside, angled four wide nearing the quarter pole and closed willingly. OUR LUCKY SON was bumped at the start and settled, raced just off the rail on the turn, was behind a wall of horses into the stretch, steadied trying to split rivals at the furlong pole then was slow to recover but finished willingly too late. AL FAATIK bumped with OUR LUCKY SON at the start but recovered to track the leaders three wide throughout and finished evenly. MY FRIEND BRUNO broke alertly but quickly fell back, was fanned five wide to the stretch and lacked the needed response. BAY STREET stalked the pace three wide, checked off the leaders nearing the quarter pole but lacked a closing response. VALLEY OF KINGS was hustled in the early stages to gain a pressing position from the inside, dueled on the turn, led briefly in the upper stretch then faded. TRICKY JOURNEY dueled two wide to the furlong pole and weakened. BUYMEABOND broke slow and was outrun.
