**Footnotes**

MAYBE TUESDAY was well positioned between horses to the second turn, responded three wide into the lane and gradually wore down PEPNIC to win going away. PEPNIC prompted the pace two wide, forged to the front into the strtch, edged clear but was caught late. WELCOME HOME RYAN lagged from the rail to the second turn, remained inside then angled widest for the drive and closed willingly. DESORMAIS lacked good early speed, angled five wide on the second turn and finished well. CAHILL CHROME stalked the pace three wide early, was fanned four wide on the second turn and lacked the needed response. HE'S CAGEY was within easy striking distance early two wide, saved ground on the second turn but did not rally. LODI RED set all of the pace from the inside to the stretch and gave way. TROPICAL HEAT lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and made up some ground belatedly. SUNDAY HEADLINE showed little. THEY CALL HIM EL ducked in at the start and unseated his rider.
