TIZANNETTE broke alertly but was permitted to slip back well off the pace and raced unhurried to the second turn, commenced her bid four wide and rallied steadily to get up in the final jumps. SARAH GOT EVEN settled early from the rail, rallied three wide into the stretch to gain command at the furlong pole then just failed to last. FAMILY SOUL was not asked for speed early, moved closer on the second turn, came three wide to the stretch and finished steadily. GOLD COAST STRIKER set the pace from the inside, edged well clear on the second turn but slackened once in the stretch. CALL ME TOUGH lagged early from the rail, raced two wide on the second turn but lacked the needed response. WILD DATE stalked the pace, saved ground on the second turn and failed to respond. KEE NOODLE was hard used into the first turn to reach the leaders, led briefly between calls on the backstretch but stopped after five furlongs and was eased.
