OLYMPIC FLAME stalked the pace from the outset from just off the rail, commenced his bid three wide on the second turn, rallied to the lead nearing the furlong pole and drew off driving. KING ROAR set all of the pace from the inside but could not match strides with the winner in the lane. REINVENT was well position from the inside, remained on the rail into the lane but did not rally. MR RONALD V. CLOUD crossed to the rail early and raced unhurried, eased three wide on the second turn but lacked a closing response. OLD MEMORIES raced unhurried early three wide, was four wide on the second turn but never reached contention. ATLANTIC PRINCE settled early, offered a menacing bid four wide on the second turn but flattened in the lane. BIG BAD BARRY pressed the pace three wide early and gave way two wide on the second turn. LATIN COFFEE dwelt at the start and came out thirty lengths last and never made up any ground. The stewards posted the inquiry but acknowledged that LATIN COFFEE'S gate indeed opened properly and made no change.
