STORM SPOTTER had the best speed, set all the pace to the second turn, responded to mid stretch then edged away under steady pressure. AWESOME SHINE was allowed to settle for a half mile, advanced inside on the second turn, shifted out for the drive, could not impact the winner but grabbed second late. D' WILDCHARM pressed the winner three wide to the second turn, raced two wide to the stretch then failed to offer the necessary response and gave up the place late. WARRIOR'S VOW was fanned four wide on the first turn, settled to the half, saved ground on the second turn but went evenly through the drive without switching leads. KIT BALADA (BRZ) hesitated and was a away slowly, settled inside to the half, eased out and tried to rally three wide on the second turn but came up empty in the drive. DIXIE MUSIC ROLL had no speed, was roused two wide on the second turn but could not muster a late response. COYOTE MOON tracked the leaders to the second turn, offered his best rally three wide to the quarter pole but could not sustain that bid and faded in the lane. CODE AMOUR stalked the pace to the second turn, came two wide to the stretch then gave way. SECURE RISK was three wide throughout and not a factor. SUMATRA'S HOPE was caught four wide throughout and always outrun.
