Footnotes

SPEED ROUSER rated beautifully in the 'catbird seat' for five furlongs, made a strong run three wide on the second turn, pushed away to mid stretch then held under steady handling. STARCAST was allowed to settle to the half, advanced into the second turn, was fanned four wide to the stretch, did not threaten the winner but was the best of the rest. NATURAL TOUCH had no speed while saving ground to the second turn, rallied two wide to the stretch then angled out for room and closed willingly in the final sixteenth. DANCIN CANDY was also allowed to settle to the half, advanced three wide on the second turn but flattened out in the final furlong. MISSILE SMOKING had no speed, closed ground despite running four deep on the second turn but slackened in the late stages. SWEET ROBERTO dueled outside of WE BROTHERS to the second turn, was overtaken into the stretch and tired through the drive. WE BROTHERS showed good speed and dueled inside for five furlongs then gave out.
