WORLDLY WAYS (GB), was never far back while three wide early, commenced his bid once on the second turn, remained three wide to the stretch, forged to the front nearing the furlong pole, drew clear briefly in midstretch but was fully extended to hold. BARTER TOWN settled just off the leaders but was fanned five wide early on the first turn, remained just off the leaders from the outside into the second turn, could not go with the winner into the lane but dug in at midstretch and was steadily gaining to just miss. HIGHLAND GOLD pressed SCOOTER BROWN two wide on the pace to the second turn, slipped back slightly into the lane but kept to his task and was coming back on late then threw his head nearing the line and finished on even terms with SCOOTER BROWN. SCOOTER BROWN set all of the pace while dropping inside, drew clear briefly on the second turn and gave way gradually in the lane. PROFOUND SECRET lagged to the stretch and finished in a late rally. CLOVER HUNTER settled early, advanced on the upper second turn while dropped inside but could not sustain his bid in the drive. MARK THE MOMENT settled within striking distance from the inside but faded steadily on the second turn. ARRIVEDERCI BABY was well positioned three wide early but came up empty. The rider aboard HIGHLAND GOLD lodged an objection against BARTER TOWN for allegedly being hit by that riders whip in the deep stretch. After reviewing the films the stewards allowed the original finish to stand explaining that the films were inconclusive.
