CHANDLERS HEART was in stride shortly after the start and set the pace without need of urging, maintained an advantage into the stretch then drew clear and held while feeling the whip only once in mid stretch. BLEACH BLONDE was permitted to settle early, raced off the rail on the turn and came on for the place without being a serious factor. FADE TO GOLD broke slow and lagged early, raced three wide to the stretch and finished with some speed. EE TO KINZIE stalked the winner from the outside, was asked to go after that rival at the quarter pole but came up empty. JAN THE FIRST broke alertly but veered in sharply while entering the main track after the start, fell back and was never a factor. AVRIL IN PARIS showed little. UNION PRIVEE stalked the leaders three wide but was pulled up suddenly on the turn then was vanned off.
