TWO BUCKS TO WIN was quickly clear from rivals then set a modest pace to the second turn, kicked away into the stretch and held under steady urging. GURNICK had no speed, trailed to the half, bid three wide on the second turn then finished with interest through the final furlong. OUR LUCKY SON checked while trying to get out on the first turn, stalked the winner to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch but flattened out through the drive. WON WON OH FIVE stumbled at the start, recovered and was outrun early, bid two wide on the second turn but could not muster a late response. REINVENT tracked the pace to the second turn, tried to rally while three deep to the stretch but lost his punch in the lane. MOUNT STERLING checked while also trying to lug a bit on the first turn, settled to the half then saved ground to no avail. CELTIC DRAMA was on the pace outside the winner to the backstretch, pressed the pace to the second turn but gave out after six furlongs.
